

Pathways to Trade

Course Description:

The Pathways to Trade course is designed for Year 10 students considering future studies in construction-related trades. This course introduces students to a variety of construction trades, highlighting the numerous career paths and tertiary education options available in the industry.

Through this course, students will:

- **Explore a Range of Trades**: Gain insight into the diverse trades in the construction sector.
- White Card: Mandatory safety training course for anyone who wants to work on a construction site in Australia provided as part of the course.
- **Develop Work-Ready Skills**: Build foundational knowledge and practical skills in a simulated trade environment.
- **Evidence:** If students are wishing to undertake Certificate II or III courses when in year 11 in Construction, Plumbing or Carpentry.
