We are pleased to announce that our application to the Construction Industry Training Board (CITB) for our Pathways to Trade course has been successful with the numbers from subject counselling.

The funding from CITB allows students to access:

- \$100 subsidised towards White card training
- PPE such as a hard hat and hi viz shirt
- As well as providing up to date industry training to Mr David Rogers for the delivery of the course.

The Pathways to Trade course is designed for Year 10 students considering future studies in construction related trades. This course introduces students to a variety of construction trades, highlighting the numerous career paths and tertiary education options available in the industry.

In Year 11 students may elect to continue into VET courses in Certificate II in Construction (General, Plumbing or Carpentry focus) or a range of other trade-based VET courses.
